




### **Prepare for Installation**





1 Attach flexible conduit (not included) to an electrical box and feed the conduit out of the cutout hole.

- Power the fixture using the following wiring diagrams according to the driver included with the fixture.







Open remote driver junction box by removing 2 screws




- 2 Mount the Remote Driver junction box in an accessible location.






# TO ELECTRICAL BOX JUNCTION BOX THUMB NUT


- Loosen the thumbnut and remove the cover from the junction box.




## Install the Fixture (Flangeless)




- Place the junction box into the ceiling.
- 2 Slide the housing in the cutout hole in the ceiling.




- Use a string or laser to align plaster plate, mark the location of the four anchor points.
- Remove the fixture from the ceiling.



- **5** Drill a pilot hole for the drywall anchor at the marked locations.
- Bore out a slight inset to allow for the head of the drywall anchor to recess into the ceiling.
- Tap drywall anchor into the ceiling.




8 Insert the fixture into the ceiling.




Secure the plaster ring in place by screwing the four provided flat head #8-32 screws into the four previously placed drywall anchors.

NOTE: Do not overtighten the screws! Overtightening may bend the plaster ring, causing the plaster surface to come away from the drywall.




- Plug the trim holder with the provided dust shield.
- 11 Properly plaster onto the plaster ring and drywall.




12 Finish around the trim to match drywall.

# Install the Fixture (Flanged)



- Place the junction box into the ceiling.
- 2 Slide the housing in the cutout hole in the ceiling




- Secure the housing by screwing in the four set screws until they are flush with the inner wall of the housing. Alternate screws before tightening all the way to ensure housing remains centered in the ceiling cutout.
- Ensure that all the tabs are tightly pushed against the ceiling; securing the housing in place.

# **Adjust Tilt**

# **TILT ARM SET SCREW**


- Tilt the light module to the desired angle.
- 2 Tighten the set screw on the tilt arm to lock in place.

# **Adjust Rotation**



- Rotate the light module to aim the light at the desired location.
  - Tighten the set screw on the rotation ring to lock in place.

# **Optics and Lenses**



- 1 Unscrew and remove the LED housing cover.
- 2 Remove the optic.
- If installing an optional lens, rest the lens inside the housing cover.
- Install the optic (replacement or existing) inside the LED housing cover.
- Screw the LED housing cover back on leaving it lessthan-snug. Stop tightening the moment any resistance is felt. The cover will not sit flush to the
